

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2003-44**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIDWAY, FLORIDA, VOLUNTARILY ANNEXING 5 ACRES OF LAND OWNED BY JIMMY AND VIVIAN HATCHER INTO THE CITY OF MIDWAY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR A LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Jimmy and Vivian Hatcher have indicated a desire to voluntarily annex approximately 5 acres of land located adjacent to US 90 into the City of Midway; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Midway, Florida, has conducted two public hearings in accordance with Florida Statutes, Chapter 171, Section 171.044 - Voluntary Annexation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Midway, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. Jimmy and Vivian Hatcher hereby voluntarily annex the following property into the City of Midway, Florida:

"Lot 4, Block A, Fortune Center as contained in the Official Records of Gadsden County, OR 428 P 134, OR 470 P 945;

Lot 5, Block A, Fortune Center as contained in the Official Records of Gadsden County, OR 428 P 134, OR 470 P 945;

OR 470 P 946 Lot 6, Block A, Fortune Center as contained in the Official Records of Gadsden County, OR 428 P 134, OR 453 P 1468.

Lot 2, Block B, Fortune Center as contained in the Official Records of Gadsden County, OR 428 P 134, OR 470 P 945;

Lot 3, Block B, Fortune Center as contained in the Official Records of Gadsden County, OR 428 P 134, OR 470 P 948."

Section 2. A copy of the Gadsden County Property records shall be attached to and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 3. A copy of this ordinance, upon adoption by the City Council, shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court and the County Manager of Gadsden County and the Florida Department of State within seven days after adoption.

Section 4. The city manager shall take appropriate steps to ensure that notice of the annexation is given to Talquin Electric Coop and that changes be made to the Florida Department of Revenue database state listing for telephone service and cablevision service to ensure proper distribution of the telecommunications services tax.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with Florida State law.
