ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-04

A ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIDWAY OF GADSDEN COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GADSDEN COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR; 2017-2018 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Midway of Gadsden County, Florida, pursuant to Florida Statute 129.03, has received and examined the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 final budget; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation with Gadsden County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City Council of the City of Midway as \$135,582,913; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Midway of Gadsden County, Florida, pursuant to Florida Statute 200.065, has computed a final millage rate necessary to fund the final citywide budget other than the portion of the budget to be funded from sources other than this ad valorem tax; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Midway of Gadsden County, Florida, pursuant to Florida Statute 200.065, advised the County Property Appraiser of its proposed millage rate, of its rolled-back rate, and the date, time and place of the first public hearing to consider the proposed millage rate and budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Midway of Gadsden County, Florida, pursuant to Florida Statute 200.065, held the first public hearing on September 23, 2017 for the purpose of hearing requests and complaints from the public regarding the tentative millage rate and budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Midway of Gadsden County, Florida, pursuant to Florida Statute 200.065, has duly advertised and held a public hearing on September 26, 2017 for the purpose of hearing requests and complaints from the public regarding the final millage rate and budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Midway of Gadsden County, Florida, that:

1. The Fiscal Year 2017/2018 final citywide operating millage rate is 5.0 mills, which is greater than the roll back rate of 4.75% mills by .95%.
2. This ordinance will take effect immediately upon its adoption
